Clara Ganslandt is since 1 September 2015 Head of Division for the EU Common Security and Defence Policy (CSDP) Partnerships and Agreements within the European External Action Service, Crisis Management Planning Directorate (CMPD). Amongst her responsibilities she is in charge of CSDP relations with international organisations, chairs the CSDP Eastern Partnership Panel, negotiates the framework participation agreements with third countries, and co-chairs a series of CSDP dialogues with partner countries.

She was born in Sweden and entered the Swedish diplomatic service in 1990.

Following Sweden's accession to the EU in 1995, she joined the first structure set up in the General Secretariat of the Council of Ministers of the EU in Brussels in order to build the EU Foreign and Security Policy (CFSP); and she has since then worked in the area of EU external relations in a number of functions, notably in institutional affairs and the area of Disarmament and Non Proliferation. She is a permanent official of the European Union and part of the European External Action Service (EEAS) since it was created in 2010.

She holds a Master of Laws (LLM) from the Lund University in Sweden and the College of Europe in Bruges and she also studied at the Institut d'Etudes Politiques in Paris.
