Anne Burgess joined Global Affairs Canada in 1997. From 1998 to 2000, Ms. Burgess served at the Canadian Permanent Mission to the United Nations in New York. Upon her return to Ottawa, she served in the Department's Legal Bureau, covering international environmental law.

From 2003 to 2007, Ms. Burgess served at the Canadian Joint Delegation to the North Atlantic Treaty Organization in Brussels, Belgium.

From 2007 to 2009, she served as Deputy Director, Defence and Security Relations, and, from 2009 to 2011, as Chief of Staff to the Deputy Minister on the Afghanistan Task Force at Canada's Privy Council Office.

From April to September 2011, Ms. Burgess served as Political Advisor to the Commander of NATO's Operation Unified Protector.

From September 2011 until August 2015, Ms. Burgess served as Deputy Director, UN, Human Rights and Humanitarian Law in Global Affairs Canada's Legal Bureau.

Since August 2015, Ms. Burgess has served in various Director positions within the Department's Stabilization and Reconstruction Task Force (START). She currently serves as Director, Conflict Policy and Security Coherence Secretariat within the Task Force.

Ms. Burgess holds degrees in law, political science and history from the University of Ottawa, Canada, and is a member of the Law Society of Upper Canada.
