Sigurd Schmidt is a Special Adviser to the High Representative, Vice President of the EU Commission, Frederica Mogherini and the European External Action Service on energy security, international energy relations, EU-US/Canada and the EU Energy Union.

He has previously held a position as Minister Counsellor in the Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs, EU Policy Department, responsible for economic affairs. He has had different positions in the Danish Foreign Policy and was coordinator of Energy and Climate issues during the Danish Presidency of the EU Minister Council in 2012, where he also led the EU follow-up to the Fukushima nuclear accident.

In 2007-11 he was on loan to the EU Commission advising the Directorate General for Energy, working on mainly Russia, the Middle East and North Africa, the Gulf and renewable energy in the Mediterranean.

Sigurd Schmidt has held different positions as a diplomat and served in Athens, Brussels and Tokyo.
